

TAKE YOUR HAZARDOUS WASTE SERIOUSLY: YOU CAN'T AFFORD NOT TO!

Removal of Hazardous Waste Off-Site

- Select a haulier who has a Waste Collection Permit which covers your local authority area and includes the relevant EWC codes. You can verify details by contacting the National Waste Collection Permit Office, Tel. 057 9357428, Email: nwcpo@offalycoco.ie, website: www.nwcpo.ie
- Drivers must be HAZCHEM / ADR certified.
- Find out in advance the destination of the waste and ensure the site is licensed.
- You need to obtain a Waste Transfer Form (WTF) on-line from the National TFS Office which can be accessed on www.dublincity.ie
- Export of waste must comply with regulations on the transfrontier shipment (TFS) of waste -S.I. No. 419 of 2007. The regulations equally apply to imports of waste into Ireland.

Completion of a Waste Transfer Form (WTF) for removal of hazardous waste

- The WTF system replaced the previous C1 Form system for movement of hazardous waste. The WTF must be completed in advance of hazardous waste leaving your premises.
- The WTF form must be completed on-line through the National TFS Office system which can be accessed on www.dublincity.ie . The fee is €6 per WTF.
